### THE LIBRARY, RENAISSANĆE **EDMONTON** AIRPORT HOTEL

Much of this hotel evokes the look of Stanley Kubrick's "2001: A Space Odyssey" with a crisp, cool palette and ultra-modern lines. The Library, deliberately, does not. Husband and wife design duo Rob Laschever and Toby Schermerhorn of Cauhaus Design introduced a warmer, residential vibe via chunky textures, natural materials and conversation pieces that look as though they were brought back from exotic places. "The overall design concept for the hotel was one of a modern ice palace," the designers say. But this lounge is a departure from the rest of the property. "While every space in this hotel may have a story, the Library was intended to be a collection of short stories," they explain. "It is a place for discovery and conversation."
